How to get started?

Before working on your resume, here are some tips on where to begin!

- Understand the job posting
- Review the mission, purpose and values of the company
- Research companies and their competitors

Building your resume



- Review formatting, spelling and grammar
- Highlight your skillsets and accomplishments
- Keep your resume up to date!
- Be concise:
 - Use bullet points
 - Tailor your resume to the role you are applying to
 - List your experience in reverse chronological order





When preparing for an interview...

- Research the company
 - What do they do?
 - Why are you interested in joining this organization?
- Research the interviewers
- Understand the main responsibilities of the role
 - Explain why you are interested in the position
 - Focus on your transferable skills
- Ask questions!
- Be yourself! We want to get to know your real self.







When answering questions...

Use the STAR Method!



Situation

- Provide context and background
- "Our customers complained . . ."



Task

- Describe problem, and challenges
- "We faced supply chain shortages..."



Action

- Explain what you did and how
- "We solved...
- "I calculated ..."



Results

- State benefits, savings, rewards, recognitions, etc.
- "The impact of . . . "

Making a great first impression

Networking in-person & virtually

- Arrive on time
- Dress appropriately and be well-groomed
- Bring something to take notes (and your resume)
- Bring a positive attitude and stay engaged
- Be mindful of time
- Send a thank you note
 - Keep it short and personalize your note!
 - Don't be shy to ask for a follow up meeting
